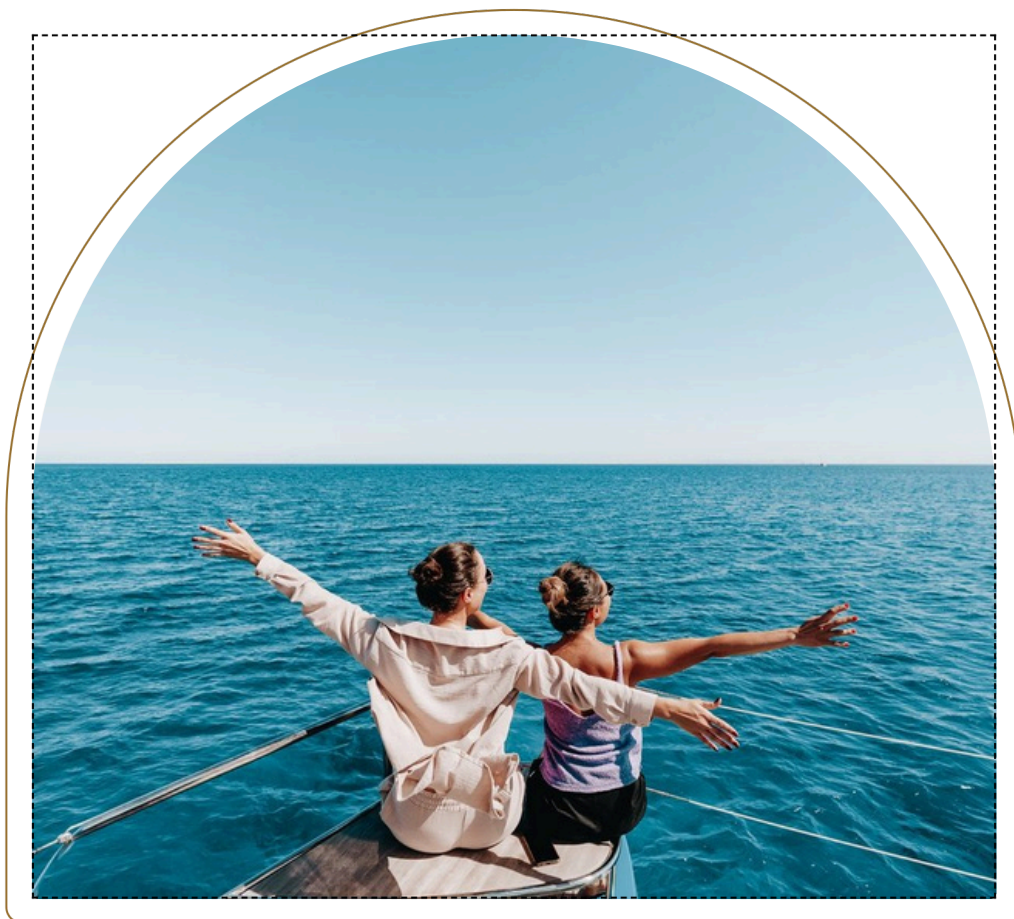

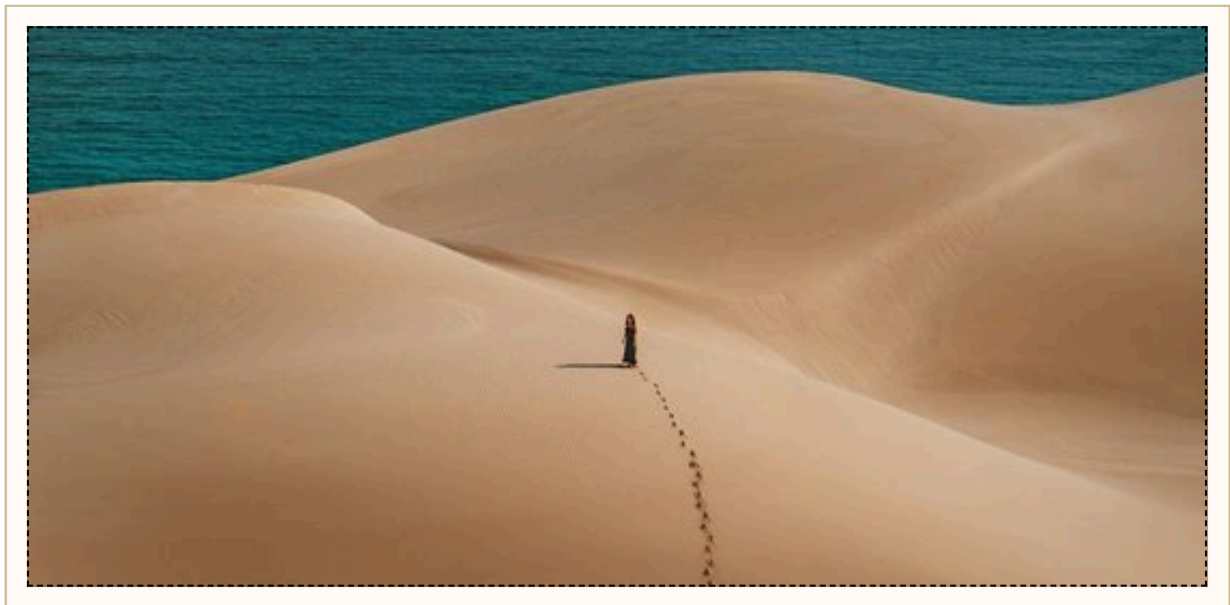


FIGURE 1.2 A NEW HORIZON

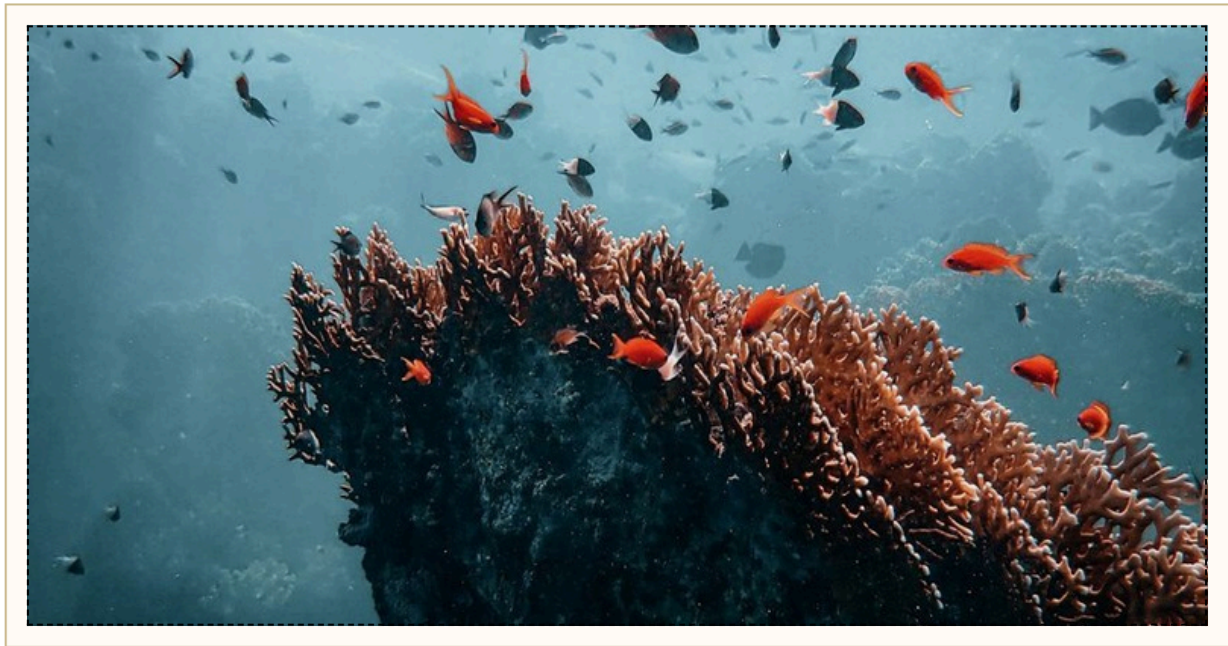


FIGURE 2.1 THE UNDERWATER WORLD

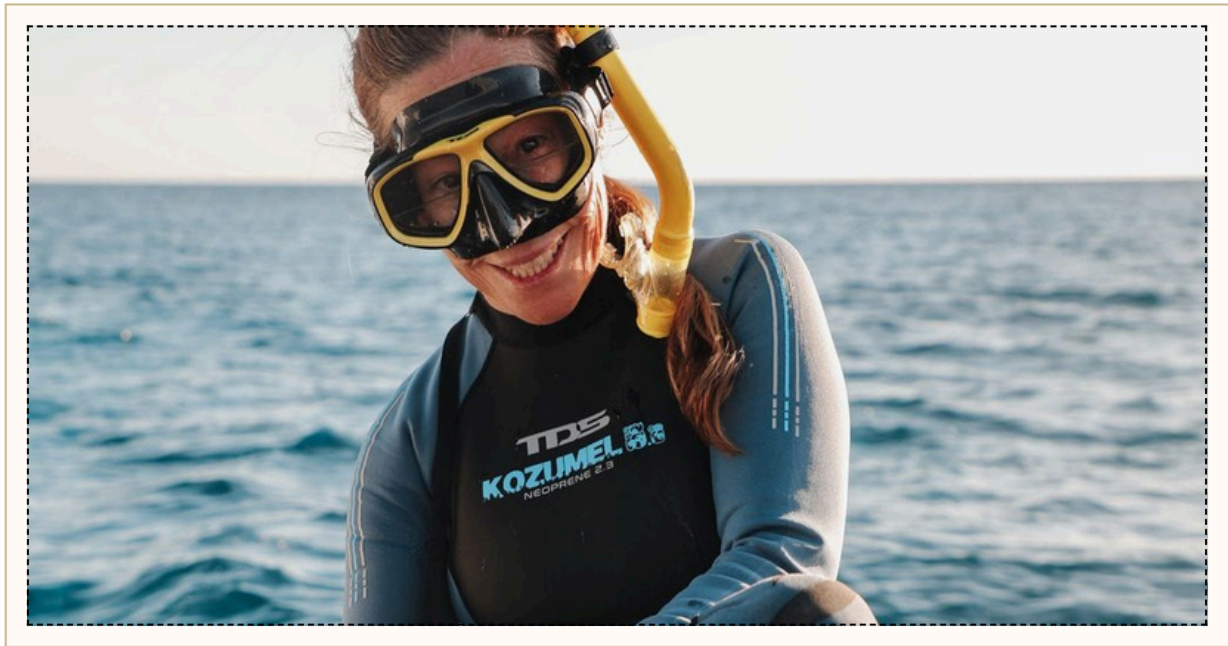


FIGURE 4.1 DISCOVER THE UNDERWATER WORLD

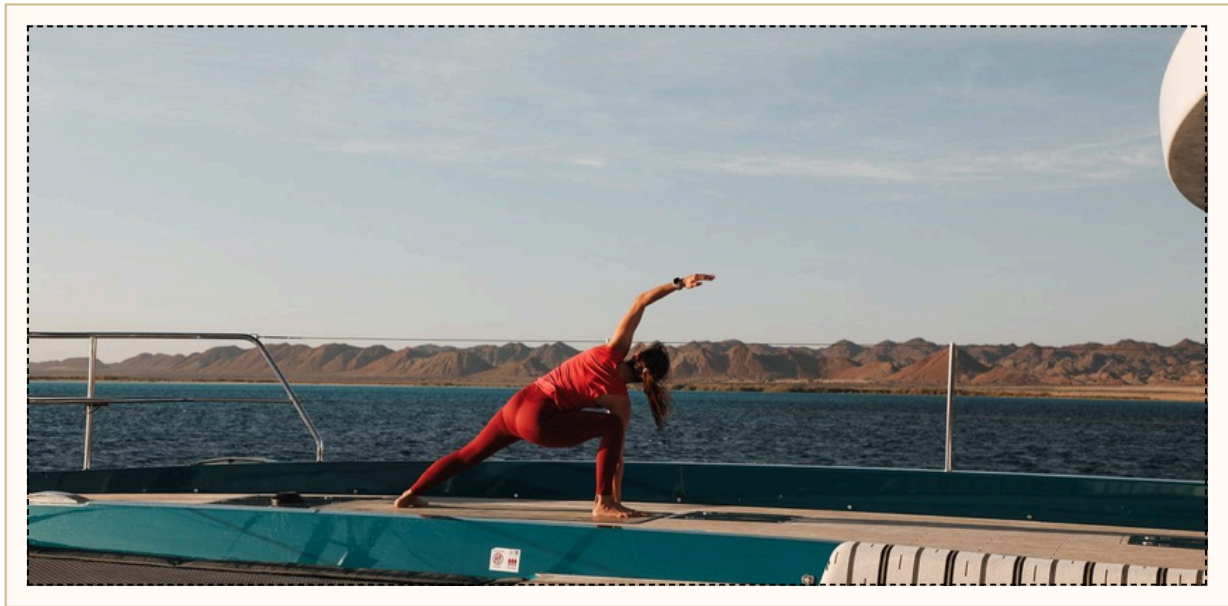


FIGURE 4.2 FINDING BALANCE AT SEA

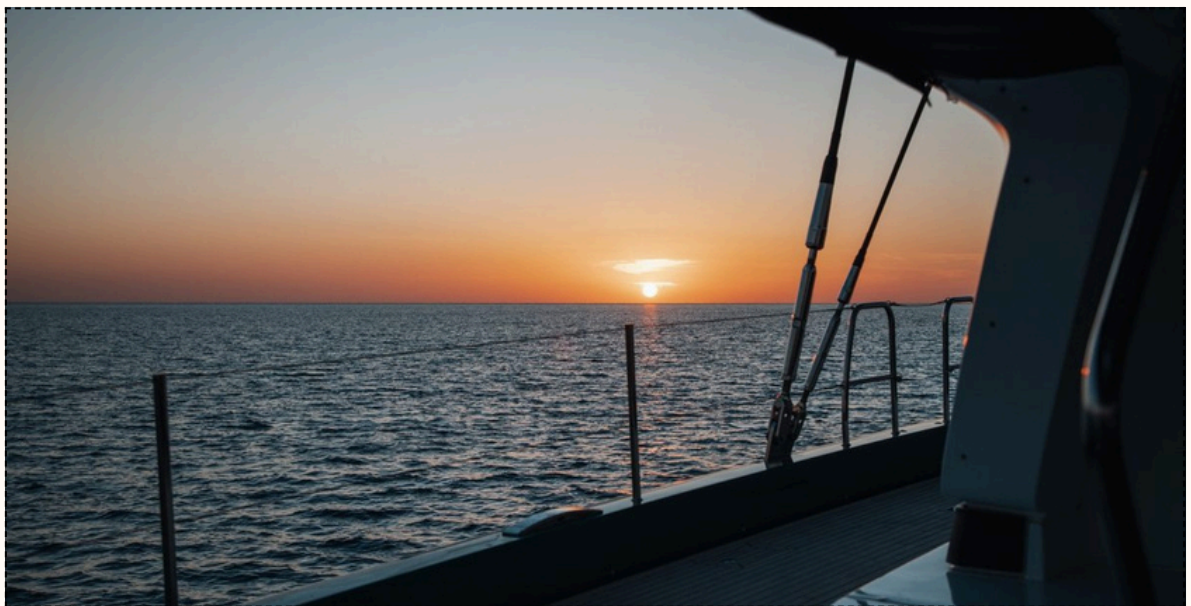


FIGURE 6.1 WHERE TIME SLOWS DOWN

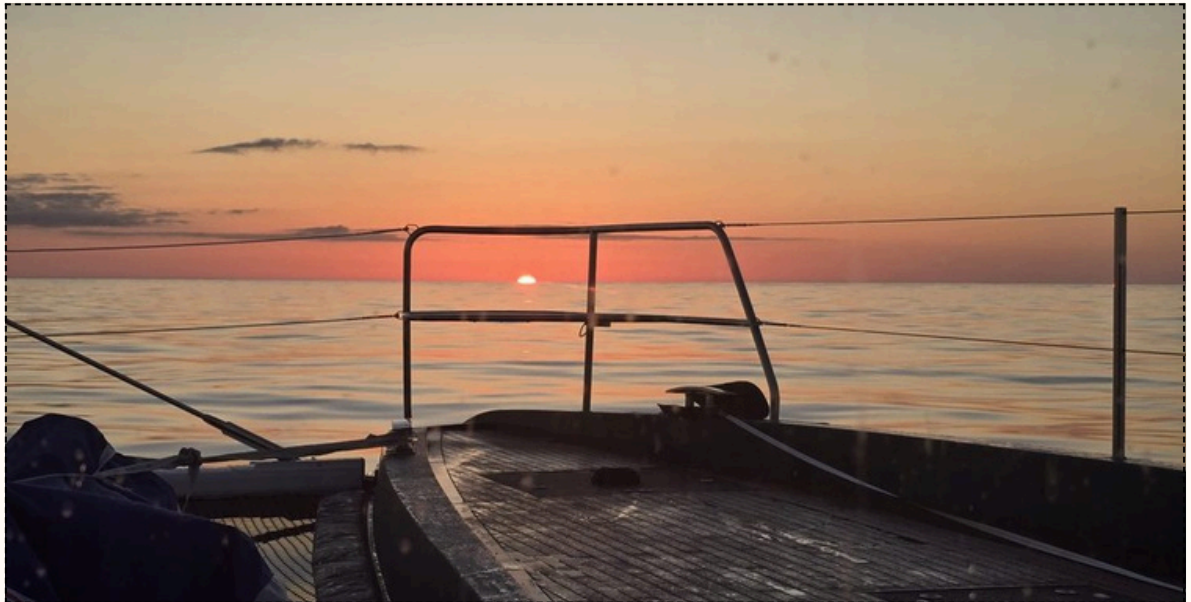


FIGURE 7.1 EVERY HORIZON HOLDS A NEW DISCOVERY

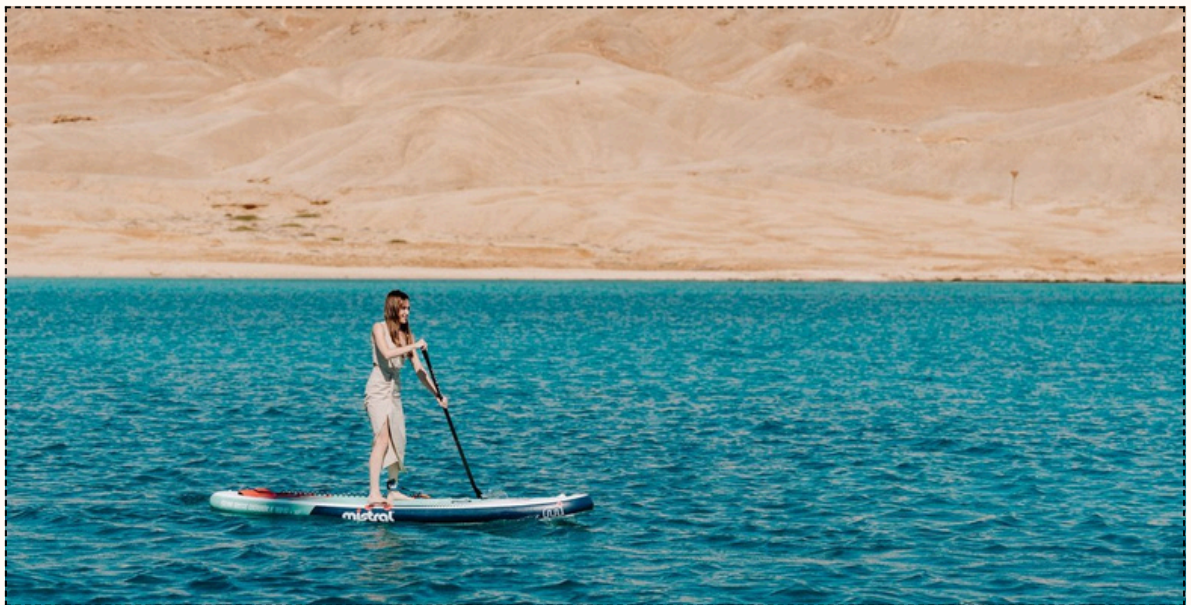


FIGURE 9.1 LUXURY IN PERFECT BALANCE

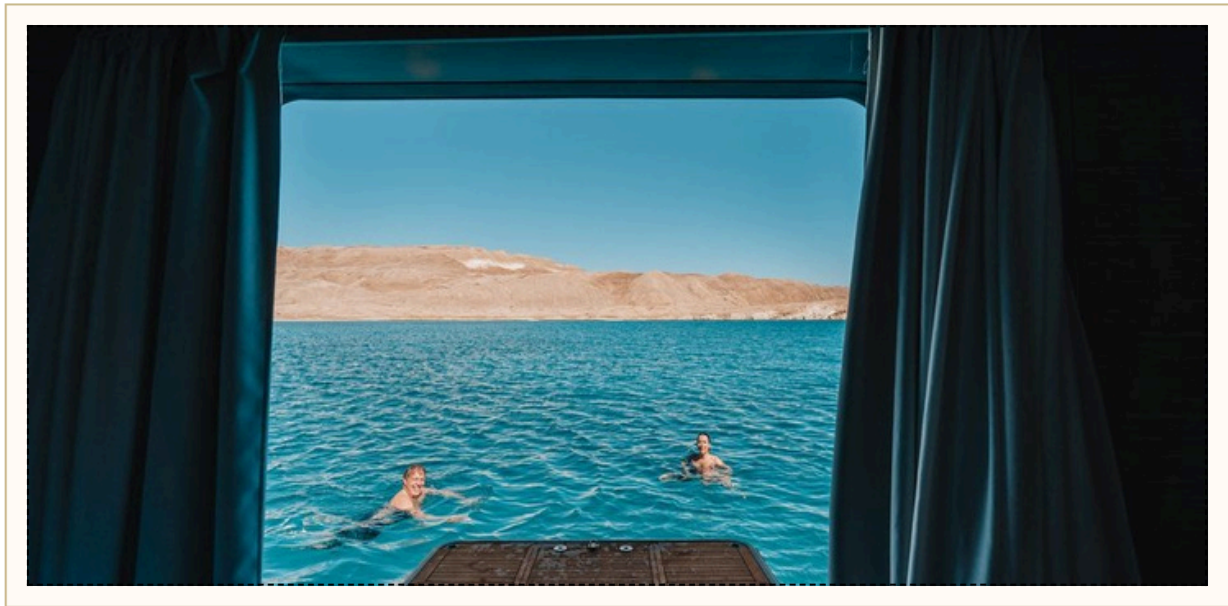


FIGURE 9.2 LUXURY, JUST OUTSIDE YOUR DOOR
